Veterans face the lens

Veterans William Helly and Janet Clough, of Wynnum, were photographed by Ms Anderson, of Dream Images studio, as part of the Australian Institute of Professional Photography's Reflections project.



Ms Anderson said more than 400 volunteer photographers across Australia had photographed more than 6000 veterans as part of the project. She said the images would be included in an exhibition at the Australian War Memorial and the veterans photographed would receive their own commem-

orative print. Ms Anderson aimed to photograph more than 100 veterans aged from 88 to 100 throughout Brisbane, the Redlands and the bayside.

"It's just been an absolute honour to meet and to photograph these people," she said. "The stories are just inspiring."
